Tournament of Play – 4 days on 16 courts on concrete floors with glass beads applied in the Ingersoll Arena.

Transportation to and from the venue – Players will be staying in Woodstock, Ontario and bussed daily to Ingersoll, which is 15 km to the west.

You'll be staying in Woodstock, Ontario (which is the Dairy Capital of Canada) in the Quality Inn and Suites. The Quality Inn is near plenty of shopping and dining. Due to government restrictions regarding Covid, we are not permitted to go into the airport to greet our shuffleboard friends at this time. Players arriving at the Toronto Pearson International, London International or Detroit Metropolitan Wayne County Airports, will need to arrange transportation. We recommend you book with the Robert Q Airbus, and they will take you directly to the Quality Inn in Woodstock. You should book in advance.

The fee for the Robert Q Airbus is at each traveler's expense.

The Robert Q Airbus is offering us a 5% per person discount off the base fare rate when booking either by phone or on-line. The promo code is **ISA39**. Here is an idea of the costing for this service, one way, with the 5% discount applied:

Niagara Falls Adventure Pass - Included

The Niagara Falls Adventure Pass includes a Journey Behind the Falls where you will take an elevator down below the Horseshoe Falls and feel the power of the mighty Niagara River. Walk through 100 year old tunnels and stand behind the great cascade as you look out from behind Niagara.

You then have unlimited transportation on the WeGo People Mover where you can hop on to be transported the Whitewater Walk and walk beside class 6 rapids. It also includes the interactive 4D movie "Niagara's Fury" This multi-sensory simulation will take you back 10,000 years to the ice age where Niagara was formed. Feel the temperature drop as mist and snow falls while immersing in the feeling of being within Niagara Falls.

Wine Flight Dinner

The day will end at Queenston Heights where you'll enjoy a three course meal including 3 x 2oz (=6oz) portions of Niagara VQA wine. Queenston Heights is a historic park nestled above the Niagara Escarpment. Take a walk to see the Laura Secord and Brock Monuments while taking in the views of the Niagara River before or after your dinner at the Queenston Heights restaurant.

Lunch at your leisure.

Clifton Hill - \$20

Clifton Hill is the main street of Niagara Falls filled with Wax Museums, haunted houses and a midway. The Clifton Hill Pass includes a ride on the Niagara Sky Wheel which takes you up 175 feet above Niagara Falls for the ultimate view. Take a journey inside a climate controlled gondola for three 3 revolutions as you marvel at the sight of both the US and Canadian falls from above.

It also includes your choice of visiting the Movieland Wax Museum or daring to ride the 6D Zombie Adventure Ride. There is mini golf and your choice between the Wild West Coaster Motion Simulator or the Haunted amusement ride known as Ghostbusters.

Horn Blower (Maid of the Mist) \$40 (this is the price as of now)

It is the number one attraction in Niagara Falls and for good reason. Hop aboard the historic Hornblower which has been in operation since 1885. The 20 minute voyage takes you into the mouth of the Canadian Horseshoe Falls where you'll be given rain ponchos to protect you from the massive spray of Niagara Falls. Come face to face with a sheet of water thundering over the 167 foot high waterfalls as you look on from inside the Niagara Gorge.
